# Beautiful IC Savings Rooftop Terrace is a work of heart

**Toronto, ON**, August 9, 2018 — The rooftop of Luso Support Centre Peel has been transformed into the IC Savings Rooftop Terrace, a spacious and tranquil area created for the centre's clients, their families, caregivers and program staff. This accessible and safe outdoor environment is designed for socializing, physical activity and enjoying the simple pleasure of being outdoors with friends and family.

"IC Savings has shown tremendous leadership and commitment within the Portuguese community and their support through *Fundo de Apoio IC Savings* will make a positive difference in the lives of the disabled," said Jack Prazeres, Chair and President, Luso Canadian Charitable Society, at an evening reception marking the official opening of the terrace. "We thank *Fundo de Apoio IC Savings* for bringing this dream of ours to reality with their generous donation."

The 4,500 square-foot outdoor space, made possible with a \$50,000 grant through *Fundo de Apoio IC Savings*, was the first project to be sponsored through the credit union's community support fund which launched in September 2017.

"Fundo de Apoio IC Savings is one way that the credit union creates value for the benefit of its members and the communities that it serves," said Frank S. Alvarez, Chair, Community Advisory Board. "On behalf of the 13,500 members of IC Savings, I share our pride in being able to support the clients, families and staff of Luso Support Centre Peel and the Luso Canadian Charitable Society. We are proud of this investment, knowing that the IC Savings Rooftop Terrace will be of lasting benefit and enjoyment to this community."

After resurfacing the entire roof and installing decking throughout, the IC Savings Rooftop Terrace offers various zones that include beds of fresh herbs and garden vegetables for use in the life skills cooking program as well as raised planting beds to accommodate clients in wheelchairs. In addition, flowers will be planted and maintained by clients, providing them the therapeutic benefits of physical exercise and a serene environment for socializing. The completed garden terrace also incorporates decorative planters, walkways, shaded seating areas including a custom-made, wheelchair accessible picnic table, a covered BBQ area and a gazebo.

Operating out of 6245 Mississauga Road in Mississauga, the centre's day program serves adults living with developmental and/or physical disabilities, as well as their families and caregivers.
